#### 1. Introduction

Since the last Sheffield Health and Care Partnership Board met, the Sheffield Oversight Committee met on 27 April 2023.

#### 2. Summary

**Review of Terms of Reference** – it was agreed at the Sheffield Health and Care Partnership Board on the 18 April 2023 that the Oversight and Transformation Committee terms of reference would be reviewed, due to duplication in some areas, and it has been suggested that a joint meeting, split into 2 parts, is held on a monthly basis, commencing with transformation and concluding with oversight.

**Place Financial Position** – the same presentation shared with the Sheffield HCP Partnership Board was outlined at the meeting on the 'place' ICB financial plan. Discussions in the Oversight Committee will be key on where we can come together to drive out efficiencies across the partnership, quantify our impact, areas we need to invest and the possibility of stopping some things we currently carry out.

**Place Performance Position** – the performance is report is currently in development and will be amended to include the 'place' priorities and milestones. The Delivery Groups will move into milestones, outcomes and KPI's and Ms Robertshaw will work with Delivery Group Leads in that space. There is still a lot of work to do, but acknowledged that some areas are moving into the right space, and cognisant that trying not to duplicate work across the system
