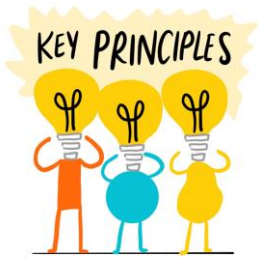

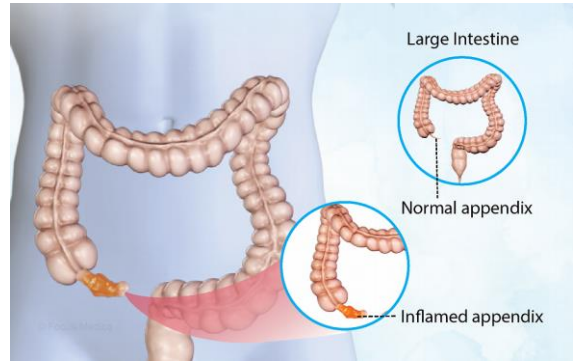

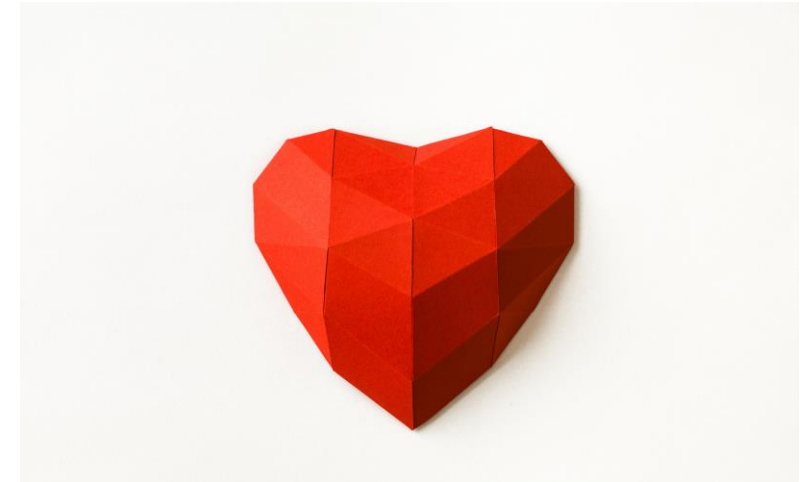
The Umbrella Effect: system working and strategy coming to life

Early Years Pilot:
aims to ensure pregnant women have access to the best advice, and adequate support to follow this advice

Core 20 Plus Oral Health Connectors:
aims to develop and support community-based action to reduce the inequalities related to oral health for CYP and their families.
